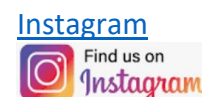


News from the Federation 28th February 2025

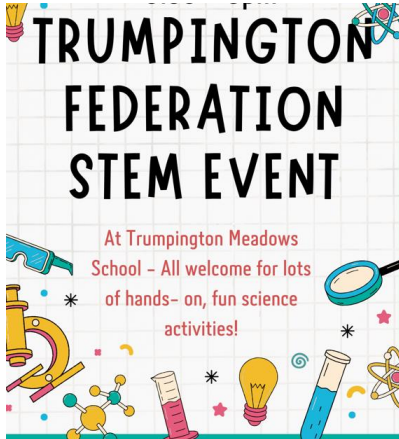
