Hand, Foot and Mouth

We have been made aware of a number of cases of hand, foot and mouth disease in different year groups recently. The official NHS advice for this condition is that children should be off school as long as they are feeling too unwell to come in but can return when feeling better, and there is no need to wait until all the blisters have healed. We will remind children of the need to ensure they are regularly washing their hands in school.

Forest School

At Trumpington Meadows, we have a number of staff specially trained in delivering forest school provision – this term so far, Y2, 3 and 6 have had the opportunity to develop their different skills in the country park area near Byron's Pool.
