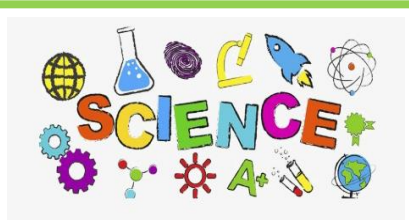
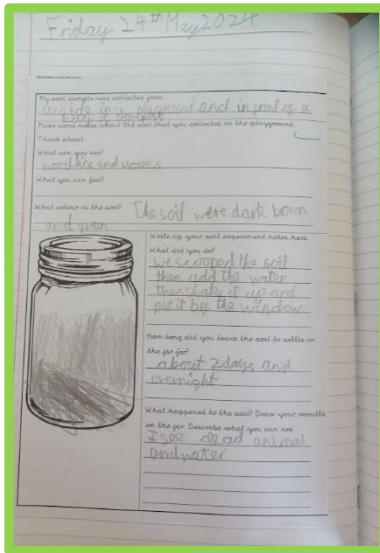




# in Year 3

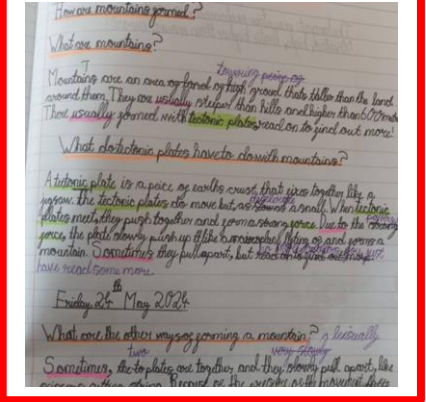
## This Month's Super Learners

In English, we have been looking at explanation texts. To begin with, we looked at the key features and purpose of explanations before writing our texts explaining how fossils are formed.

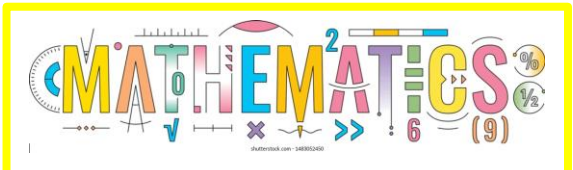
We really liked doing the research for this – we found some amazing facts!
