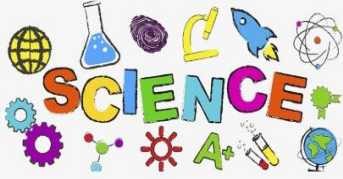




in Year 4

We have used cress to investigate the effects of deforestation and also how plants grow in different environments. We've linked this to our previous topic of Vikings and why they migrated to Britain for food.

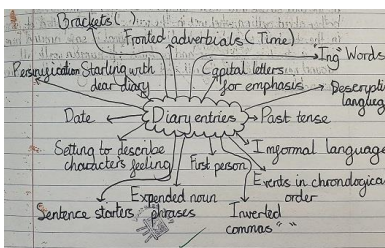
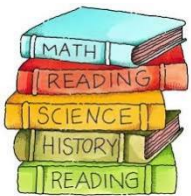
