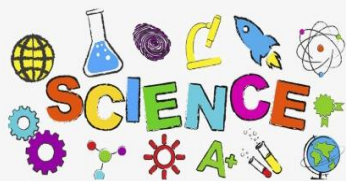

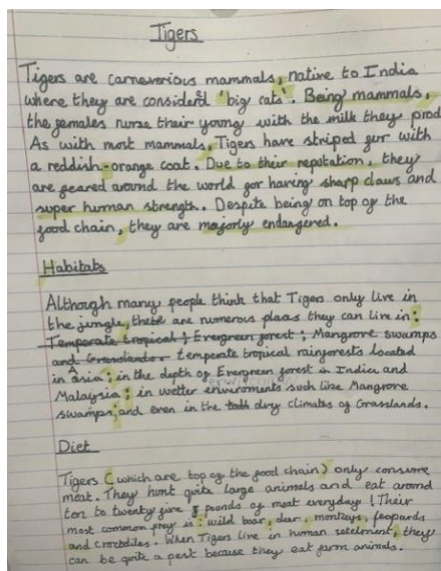

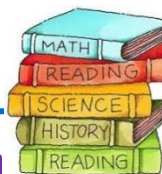
In English, we completed our SATs papers in reading, spelling, grammar and punctuation. What a lot of information we have learnt!
