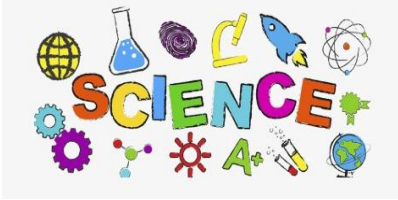


# July

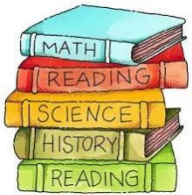

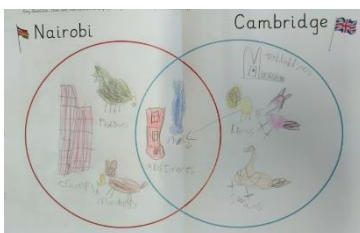

In Geography, we have continued learning about Kenya. We have discussed some of the human features found in Kenya and made comparisons between Nairobi and Cambridge.



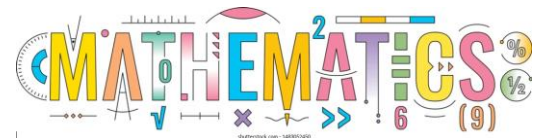
In Art, we have been creating bird sculptures using cardboard, paper and paperclips. These looked fantastic and we had lots of fun making them.



In English, we have been learning about diaries. We discussed the features of a diary and read a diary entry written by Paddington about his adventures in London.

We have written our own diary entries about a day at school, as well as diary entry about our day on the boat trip.

In Guided Reading sessions, we have read *Actual Size*, *Supertato* and *Lost and Found*.



In Maths this month, we have been consolidating and applying lots of our learning from earlier this year. We have revisited our learning on fractions. We found one half and one quarter of shapes, then we found halves and quarters of quantities.

We then recapped our learning on place value with numbers to 100. We have made 2-digit numbers using different manipulatives and discussed the number of tens and ones in each number. We have also ordered and compared these numbers and found one more and one less.
