News from the Federation – 28th June 2024



Alongside this newsletter, you will have received a letter sharing with you the name of your child's class and teacher for the 2024-25 academic year. On Monday, your children will spend the day with their new teacher as part of our transition process – they will need to go to the door of their new classroom at their usual start time. They will have been told where this is but if you are unsure, adults will be on the playground to help out on Monday!

As mentioned in recent newsletters, we have had to take the decision to close some classes for the next academic year. You will be aware that English state schools are currently facing real challenges with funding and therefore class sizes below 20, as we have had in some year groups, are financially unsustainable. We have made the decision to avoid mixed-age classes this year, as we feel this is best for the children; however, we have had no choice but to combine smaller classes moving forward. I appreciate this might cause some parents concern but can reassure you we have thought carefully about how to ensure the best possible provision for all children, given the difficult national context.
