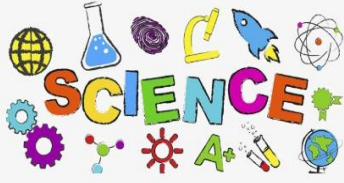




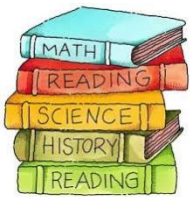
in Year 6

Year 6 are very much immersed in the world of theatre currently! We are regularly rehearsing and working hard to perfect our singing, transitions and panto-esque acting!



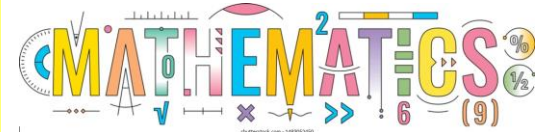
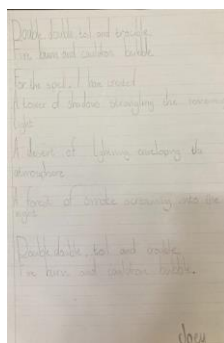
In Geography, we looked at the physical and human characteristics of Africa. In groups, children researched an African country focusing on its economic activity and how this compares to the UK.
