Keeping Children Safe – Invacuation Drill Practice

Keeping children safe is our top priority and with this in mind, we will be having an invacuation drill practice over the next week or two. It should be noted that the procedure cannot cover all eventualities and is not designed to cause alarm. Children have already been made aware of what they need to do, should they hear the alarm. Children who may struggle with particular parts of the procedure, for example due to their SEND, will have alternative plans developed. This drill will become part of our safety practice, just as we do with a fire alarm.
