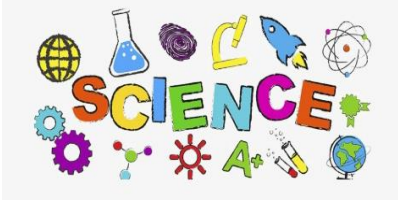




# in Year 4



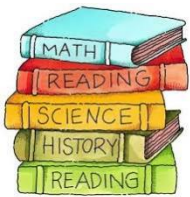
