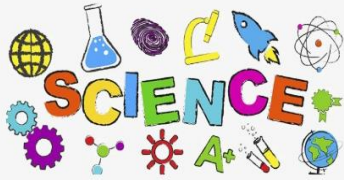

This month in Science, we have been finishing off our life cycle unit, looking at David Attenborough and thinking about using our scientific knowledge to become researchers into animals.

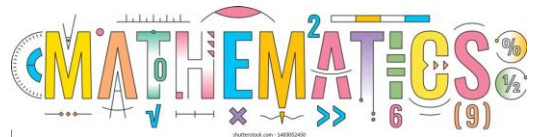
