## THIS MONTH'S SUPER LEARNERS:

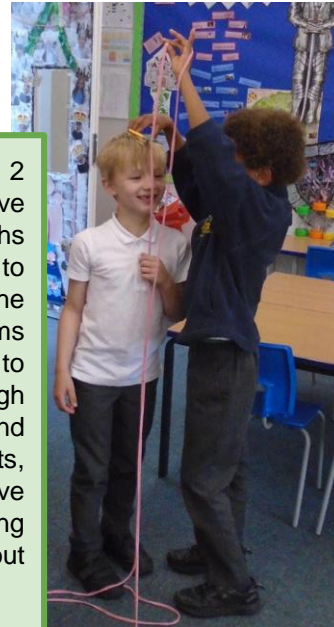

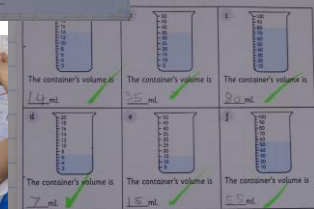

Water bottle cap	700g	175g	The <u>water bottle cap</u> weighs <u>175g</u> grams.

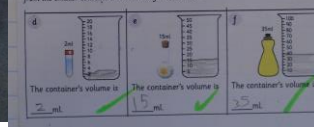
The heaviest object was the water bottle.
