In Science, we have been learning about seasonal changes, focusing on Autumn. We talked about what months are in Autumn, what the weather is like, events and celebrations, what happens to animals and plants and how daylight changes. We collected Autumn leaves and sorted these in different ways.

In Geography, we have been learning about our local area and have identified our school on a map. We have talked about human and physical features in our local area and in the playground and we have used directional language to locate these.

In Art, we have focused on printmaking, including making leaf rubbings.

In RE, we have been talking about Diwali, christenings and how birthdays are celebrated around the world.

In PSHE, we have been discussing what makes a good friend.

In English, we have been reading The Tiger Who Came to Tea. We learnt the story, added actions and wrote our own versions of the tale. We used time conjunctions (first, then, next, after that, finally) to order the events chronologically.

We have written and published our own poems about Autumn and Winter, using our senses to describe the seasons.

In Phonics, we have learnt the sounds ve, y (as in sunny), oo (as in moon), oo (as in book), ch, sh, th and oe.

In our Reading lessons, we have read Home, Silly Billy and The Oak Tree.



We started the term by learning about volume and capacity. We measured the capacity of different containers and ordered the volume of containers by using the words empty, nearly empty, half full, nearly full and full.

We have also been learning about weight and mass. We compared the mass of objects using balance scales and found out which were the heaviest and lightest. We measured the mass of the objects using multi-link cubes.

We have talked about days of the week, months of the year and different times of day. We have started learning our 1 times table.
