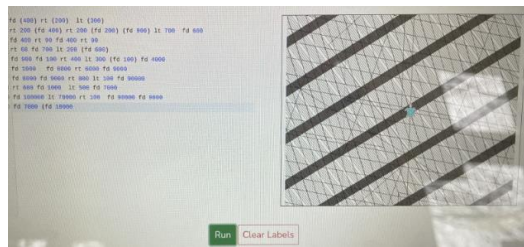
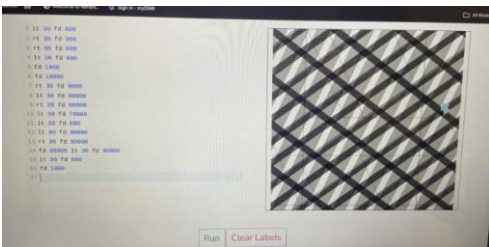

You may already be aware and have heard the children identifying their feelings and emotions linked to a colour (red, blue, yellow or green) these are the zones. Ultimately, green is the zone we aim to be in for learning and wellbeing. We are now planning to develop this tool further to fully embed it into school life for the learning and wellbeing for all. The benefits of this program include increased self-awareness and social and emotional skills, a common language for communication, problem solving and emotional understanding as well as more time spent on learning instead of management behaviour making school a healthier, more inclusive climate.

The Little Makery: Calling Young Artists at Fawcett in Year 1-3



Is your child in Year 1, 2 or 3 and enjoys art and design? Our art and design clubs are all about having **fun** and **nurturing creativity**. We **teach techniques** and **skills in a range of media** and **give children choices, time, space** and lots of **encouragement**. Sessions have a relaxed feel and are taught by an experienced primary teacher and art specialist. A 1:10 teacher to child ratio means that children have the support they need to thrive.

Pricing and Booking

The Little Makery runs weekly (after-school) clubs and day-long, holiday clubs. Clubs are booked through The Little Makery website and prices include materials.

- **Weekly clubs** run from the end of the school day for 90 minutes. They are booked on a termly basis and are priced at £15/ session.
- The Little Makery offers a limited number of FREE places for children entitled to Pupil Premium funding. We offer a limited number of subsidised places for children with an EHCP who have 1:1 TA support at school.
