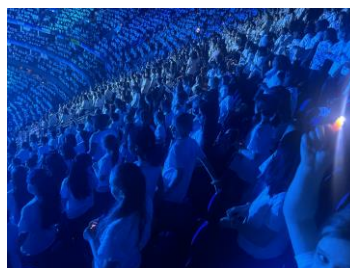
Next Tuesday is Safer Internet Day 2025. I am sure most parents would agree that helping children to safely navigate the online world is a top priority given how much time we all spend on the internet, and the risks that are posed. In school, children regularly have learning on how to keep themselves safe online, and these lessons tend to fall under one of the 'four Cs': Content (how to avoid dangerous material online), Contact (managing the risk of interacting with others online), Conduct (helping children behave appropriately online) and Commerce (making children aware of the risks from online gambling, phishing and other scams). We often find that children can confidently explain what they should do but still make risky mistakes when they are online.

To help support parents with managing this minefield, all KS2 parents are invited to a session in school on Thursday which will consist of some information and resource-sharing from Mrs Crush before spending some time in class with your children completing some online safety activities. We would love to see many of you coming along!
