



We spend a lot of time in school working with children on managing their emotions, developing their social skills and building their resilience and perseverance. It is an important message for children that sometimes things do not go the way we might want them to, and supporting them to navigate these, sometimes difficult, situations is a key part of growing up. Staff spend a lot of their time working on this and parents have a key role to play, in discussing issues through with their children and helping them to feel listened to, whilst also seeing things from other people's perspectives.

One tool we use in school to help children communicate their feelings is the Zones of Regulation, where children are encouraged to express how they are feeling and place these emotions in one of the four zones (blue, green, yellow, red). Staff have all had further training on this so this will help explain if you hear your child speak about being in the 'green zone' (hopefully!).

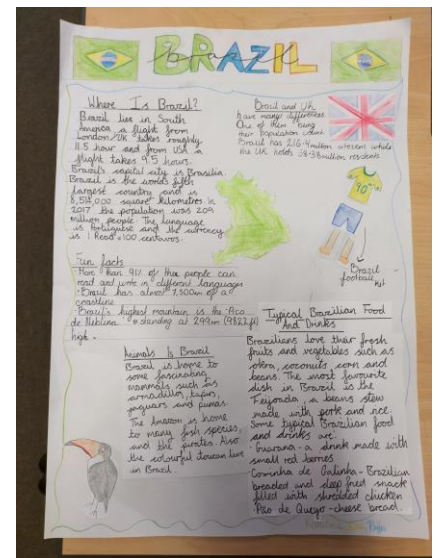
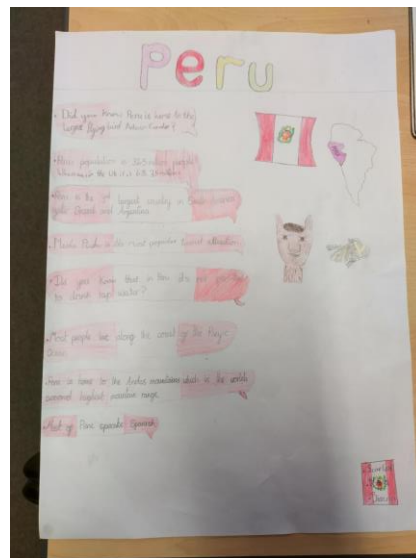
STEM EVENT – Thursday 13th March
