This has been a big part of our teacher development; the upcoming focus of which is on small, effective strategies teachers can use to adapt learning so that all children, in all lessons, are able to make good progress and achieve well.

The students were also accompanied by an inspector from OFSTED who was exploring how teacher training programmes support their trainees to develop their teaching skills (the inspector was not inspecting us!) It was pleasing to hear from the trainees during their feedback that they felt very quickly that the school was a caring community where nurture and inclusion shone through. 
