News from the Federation – 17th January 2025



We have been informed by Cambridgeshire County Council that the local authority will be having their OFSTED inspection, focused on their SEND processes and partnership, over the next two weeks. As part of this process, there is an opportunity for parents and carers of young people with SEND (and any professionals who work supporting pupils with SEND) to express their views on SEND in Cambridgeshire via the OFSTED survey – the link for this can be found here: https://ofsted.smartsurvey.co.uk/p/AreaSend/10352388

Times Tables

For parents in KS2, do look in the back of your child's reading record to see their most up to date TT Rockstars heatmap. This will give you an idea of the progress that they are making with learning their times tables. The colours change from red to green the quicker the children are able to recall the facts. All children have an account they can use at home and can try and beat their personal high score!
