In Maths, we continued working on place value through addition and subtraction. Pupils worked hard at adding numbers mentally. They then moved onto adding and subtracting three-digit numbers and ones, threedigit number and tens, and three-digit number and hundreds, including adding on a number line. We also began to use formal written methods for column addition and subtraction.

In Religion Studies, we explored the traditions of Judaism. Children explored the importance of the Ten Commandments and the Torah. They also recreated and decorated Jewish symbols, such as the Hamsa Hand. In addition to this, they explored some key associated beliefs such as protection against the evil eye and negative energies. Some beautiful, colorful drawings were produced to represent this.
