


In English this month, we have been finishing our learning on Explanation Texts – look at the beautiful learning we have done!






We have also started our learning on moral stories, what the purpose of a moral story is and how to use contrast to create a mood for a reader.




During our reading lessons, we have been looking at various texts, and the children really took to one specific text in particular – Cogheart. Here is an example of how we use our new text marking skills in our fluency lessons. Text marking helps the children to develop the fluency skills needed to read with accuracy and expression.





In Maths, we finished our learning on fractions by using fractions of amounts/a quantity – this is a tricky concept and we have created steps to remember how to find the fraction of a number. Have a look!



We have started our work on decimals, recognising decimals up to 2 decimal places and the relationship between the place value of the digits.
