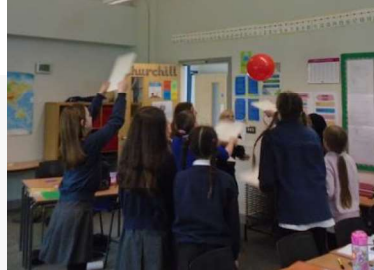
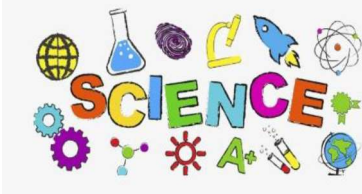


FEBRUARY in Year 5



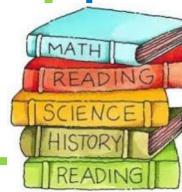
In Science this month, we finished learning about the planets and our solar system – we created interesting fact files about the solar system (including why it is called a solar system).

We have started looking at Forces – here we are trying to keep a balloon in the air, without physically touching it! We have been learning lots about gravity.

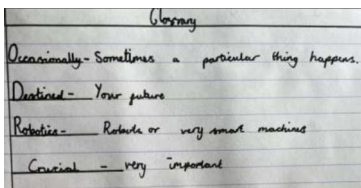

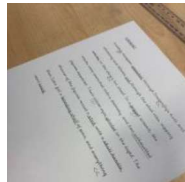
We have completed our unit on explanation texts... we included a Glossary in our work, like this one, to help our readers understand technical terms:



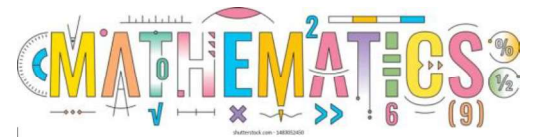
We have also started our learning on moral stories; what that might mean, and how to use contrast to create a mood for the reader.

During our reading lessons, we have been looking at various texts, including, 'Cogheart'.

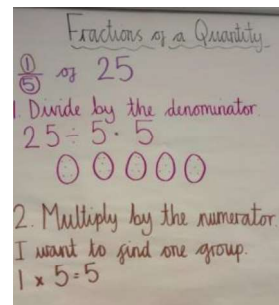
This is a text marking example from our fluency lessons:
