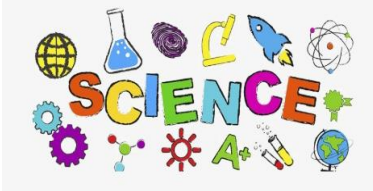




in Year 1

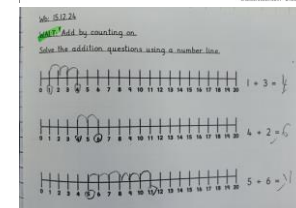

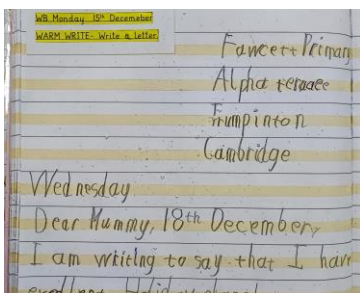
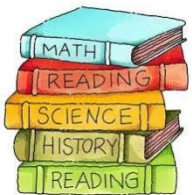

In maths we have been learning how to add on a number line

and exploring number bonds within 20 using Numicon and part-whole models.
